## SSRC Reorganizes amidst Growing Support from Scientific Community

The Space and Science Research Corporation (SSRC), formerly the Space and Science Research Center, announces today that it has completed an important reorganization while simultaneously expanding its list of "Supporting Researchers" including some of the world's leading scientists.

Mr. John L. Casey, now President of the SSRC, explains the reasons for the changes by saying, "Just over three years ago when I activated the SSRC, it was clear that it was going to be an uphill battle to convince the scientific community, our leaders in Washington, and the media that a new climate change to one of decades of cold weather was coming. After having made a highly controversial set of predictions during 2007-2008 for the start of a solar hibernation, the end of global warming, a long term drop in global temperatures and the start of a potentially dangerous new cold climate, it is of course gratifying to have finally reached this stage in the SSRC's development with all of those predictions having come to pass. The new SSRC structure will significantly assist in the acquisition of capital and research funding and give added flexibility to the SSRC.

Along the way I have been fortunate to find a growing number of scientists who shared my research conclusions and predictions for the future. Today I am immensely proud to say that the list of highly respected researchers who support the efforts of the SSRC has grown substantially. In addition, I believe the world is rapidly coming to the same general conclusion as we have that the past era of global warming has in fact ended, and our next climate of predominantly colder weather has begun.

The NASA data on the Sun which was released in January 2011, has confirmed the start of the next grand solar minimum; what I call a 'solar hibernation.' With that prediction now verified, there can be no doubt that the world has entered a period of two to three decades of cold weather which will also be punctuated by some of the largest volcanic eruptions and

earthquakes in recorded history. It is this combination of ill-effects from the next solar hibernation that has prompted me to seek out the world's top researchers in several fields to address the nuances of this new climate era. I am pleased to publish the expanded list today of these talented experts who have become 'Supporting Researchers' at the SSRC.
